Enforcement Rules of EMI AI Innovative Application

Microprogram

Approved on July 30, 2025, during the second semester of the academic year 113, by the Second Committee meeting of International College of Innovation

- Article 1 To foster a fully English-taught environment, enhance students' international competitiveness, and cultivate interdisciplinary talents equipped with AI technologies and industrial application capabilities, the International College of Innovation ("the College") hereby establishes the EMI AI Innovative Application Microprogram ("the Microprogram") for students to enroll in.
- Article 2 The College shall be responsible for course planning, student academic affairs review, and other related matters pertaining to the Microprogram.
- Article 3 Course planning and offerings shall follow the "Curriculum List of the Micro Program." Students must complete 3 credits of foundational courses, 6 credits of advanced courses, and 3 credits of applied courses—a total of 12 credits—to be eligible to apply for a Certificate of Completion.
- Article 4 Students who have completed all required courses and credits for the Microprogram with passing grades must apply for the Certificate of Completion from the Microprogram before the end date of their final semester. The certificate will be issued upon verification by the Microprogram.
- Article 5 Any matters not covered in these regulations shall be handled in accordance with National Chengchi University Regulations, National Chengchi University Microprogram Regulations, and other relevant rules and regulations.
- Article 6 These Guidelines shall be implemented following approval by the College's Committee meeting and submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs for reference. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments.
